HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR PARENT FEE

EXAMPLE:

If you have an 18-month-old child you would like to send to a licensed provider for five (5) days per week, this is how you would calculate the payment:

- If the child care provider charges \$25 per day for care, then $\$25 \times 5 \text{ days} = \125
- If the parent fee for this example is \$2 a day, then $\$2 \times 5 \text{ days} = \10
- Care for 18-month-old is $\$23 \times 5 \text{ days at Licensed center} = \115
- So, the amount the family is responsible for paying is \$20.
- $\$125 = (\text{Amount provider expects to be paid})$
- $\$115 (\text{State funding}) - \$10 (\text{parent fee}) = \$105 (\text{Maximum amount the State will pay})$
- $\$125 (\text{Provider cost}) - \$105 (\text{State payment}) = \$20 (\text{amount you are responsible to pay per week})$
